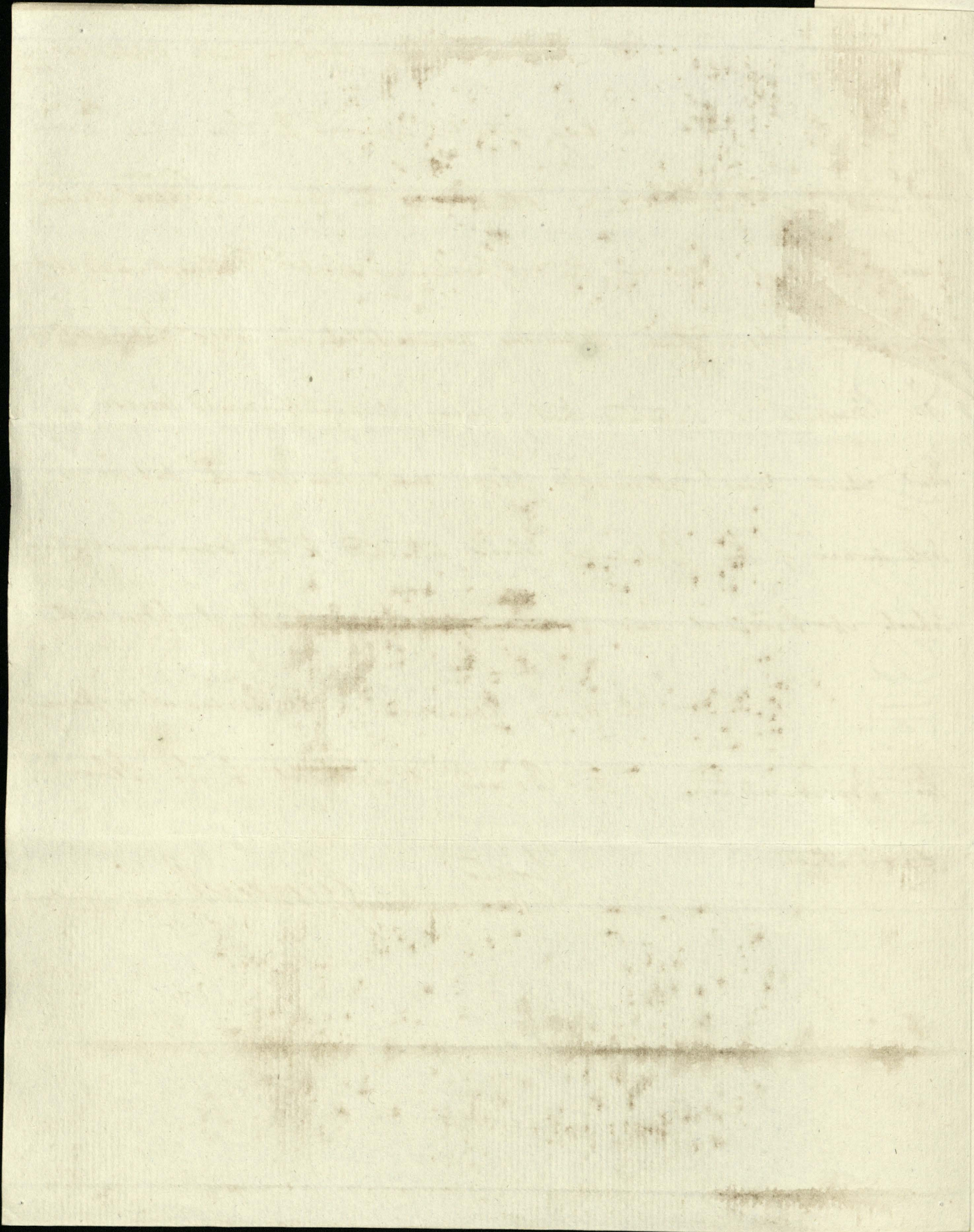


Windsor Castle October 17th

The King entirely approves the steps which Mr
Boscawen has taken towards obtaining the general support of Lord
Sidmouth and securing the assistance of Mr Bathurst and Mr
Penshurst. Upon these occasions, as indeed in every transaction,
His Majesty is satisfied that a fair, straightforward course is
that which must ultimately prove most beneficial, but he is
well aware of the delicacy which attaches to the communication
which Mr Boscawen has made to Lord Innes and Lord Sidmouth.

the Presidency of the Board of Longitude to Sir John
Astruc.
