Friday

My dear Daniels

I will beg you to give the enclosed papers to the Cook as rules for her to go upon in everything and never, will you explain to her, to be devoated from — I think of you the the women by dinner she ought not to have more than 3 Shillings a week. — Think you will enquire about the Rooms for the Servants as they are of great consequence & I like to see them all prepared by my arrival you will have received some lines you had better buy a sack of Flour if there is a place to keep it — Pray arrange about Milk (no cream) enough for 9 Persons & allowing enough for three Puddings a week. I will be to look along the line & the enclosed but for the first Wednesday & she will see what she is to get for dinner on the day, the day after we arrive — My Postman will come as far as Reggate with us on Tuesday and not read Budy till the following morning — My Great Servant will however be there on Monday by the last. If anything should keep us back at you know & if we should not come

before half past seven, suppose somebody
 has detained us - Do try & strike
 a point about the Rooms for the
 servants - I have little else to say
 to you & wish I took on Saturday
 you can let me have a dish
 of fresh water fish from the Ponds

I hope to hear from you Monday
 morning & Tomorrow - In hanging
 up the Picture over the Sofa allow
 it to be 2 feet above it as I have
 something to hang under it, and
 put the Picture over the Piano forte
 on a line with it - You will find nails
 for the Pictures in the workshop at
 Gravelly -
