

George FitzClarence to Daniell

[Aug 28 1821]

Take care the Beds are well aired —
 & put Mess along the ^{side} of my
 Father & the Duches & of the other Beds as
 far as they will go — Put the Spa into
 the Kings Room — Put out of the Substantives
 with paper Pins Ink & Stationery in the
 Prince's Room, one in the Cambridge Room,
 one in the Hall Room & one in the Company
 Drawing Room & put a Silver Hat candle
 with each — You had better buy four
 size Portfolios full of blotting Paper
 for these rooms — Have several Key-stones
 & Paperweights and pens
 ever waiting — But they
 should ever be ready
 There must be also a writing
 table in each of these rooms besides the
 Dressing Table — Bismut must be ordered
 when the time comes to make a little
 Box to lock with a key — A place also to
 put letters in to be on the Hall Table for
 letters going to the Post — Adam must
 keep the Key — My Father was much
 better yesterday — Ever for Y^r C^t
