 Pounds.

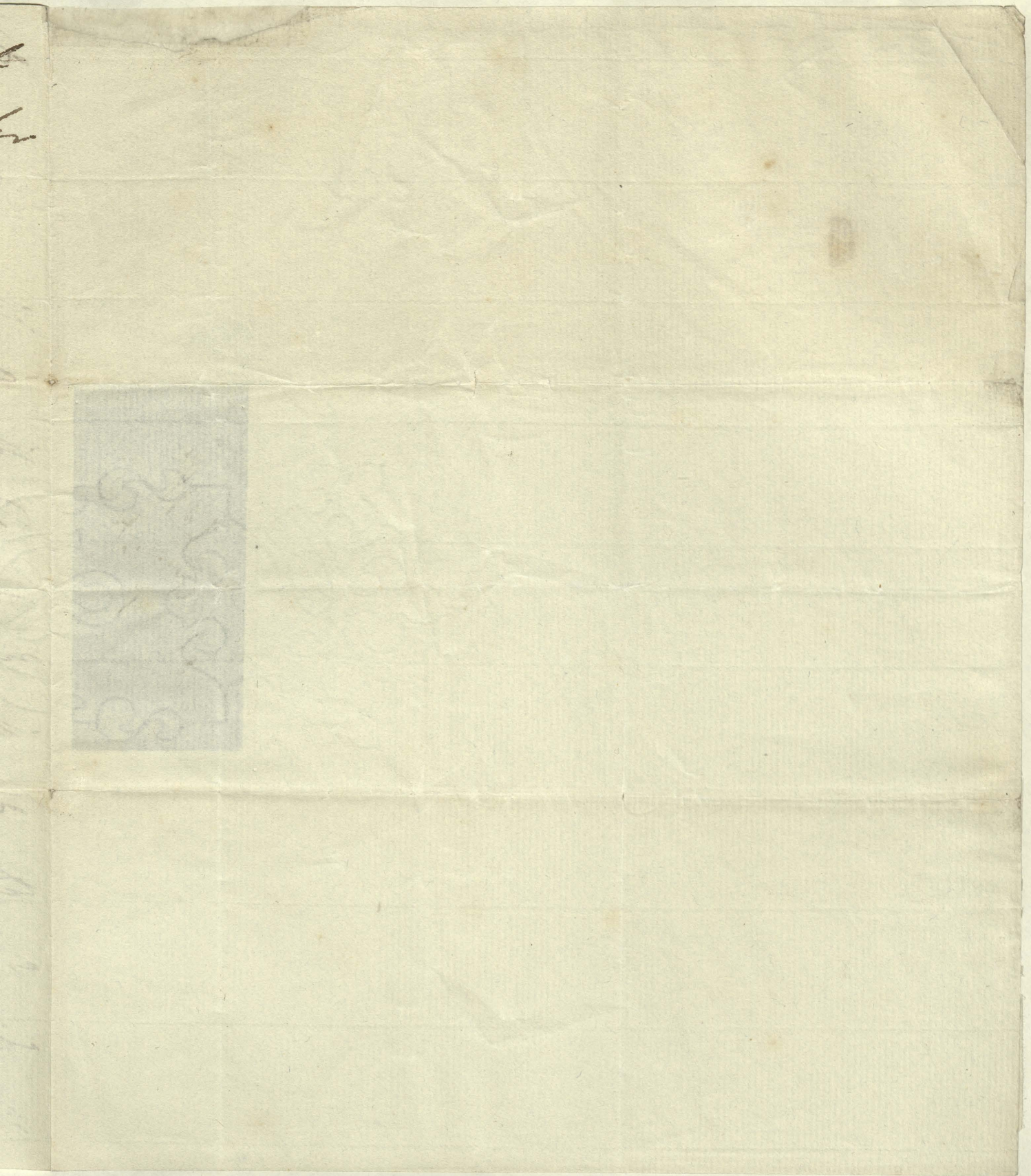
You are doing right with Bennett and I only
