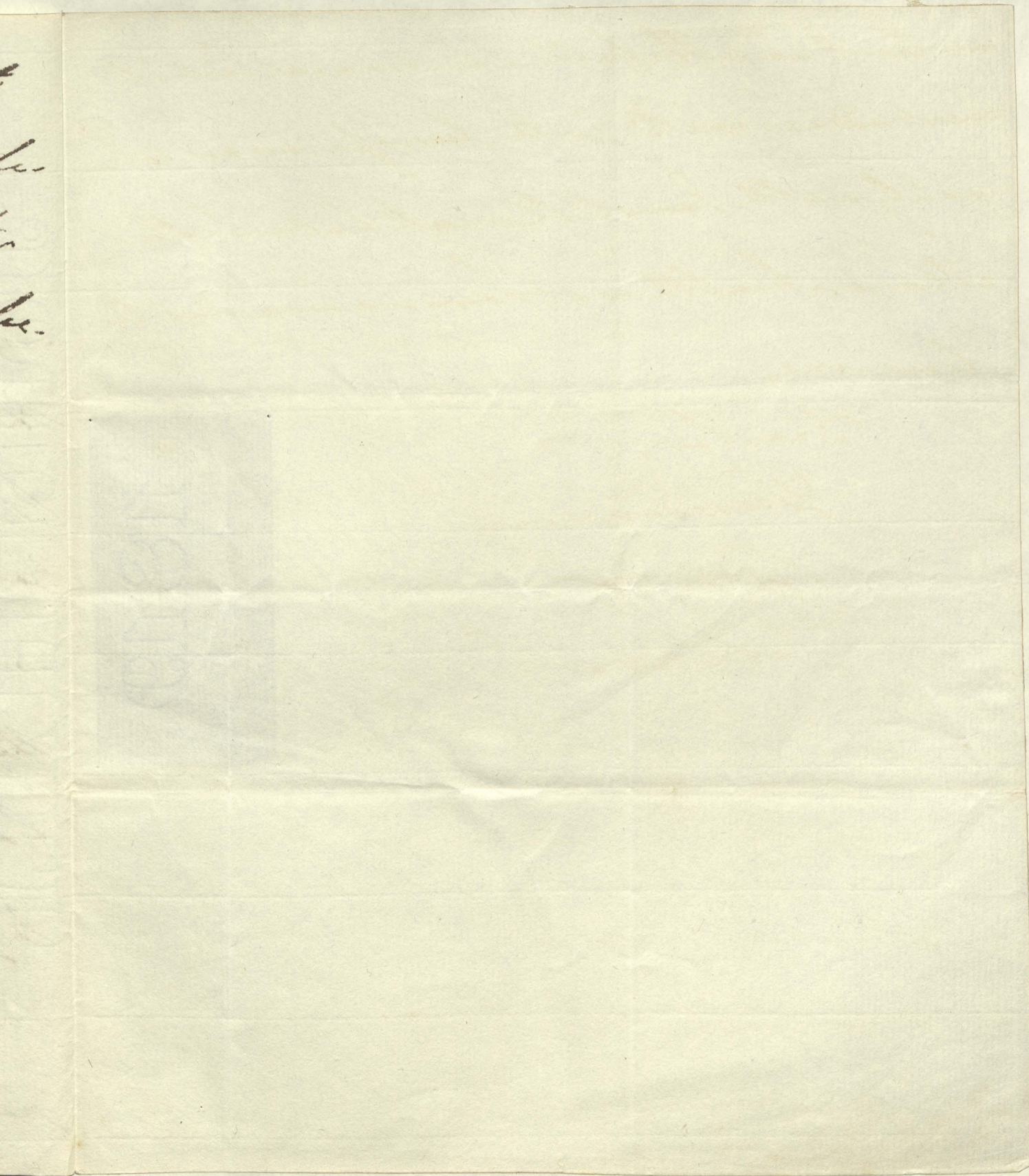


Walsingham.
