Dear Daniell;

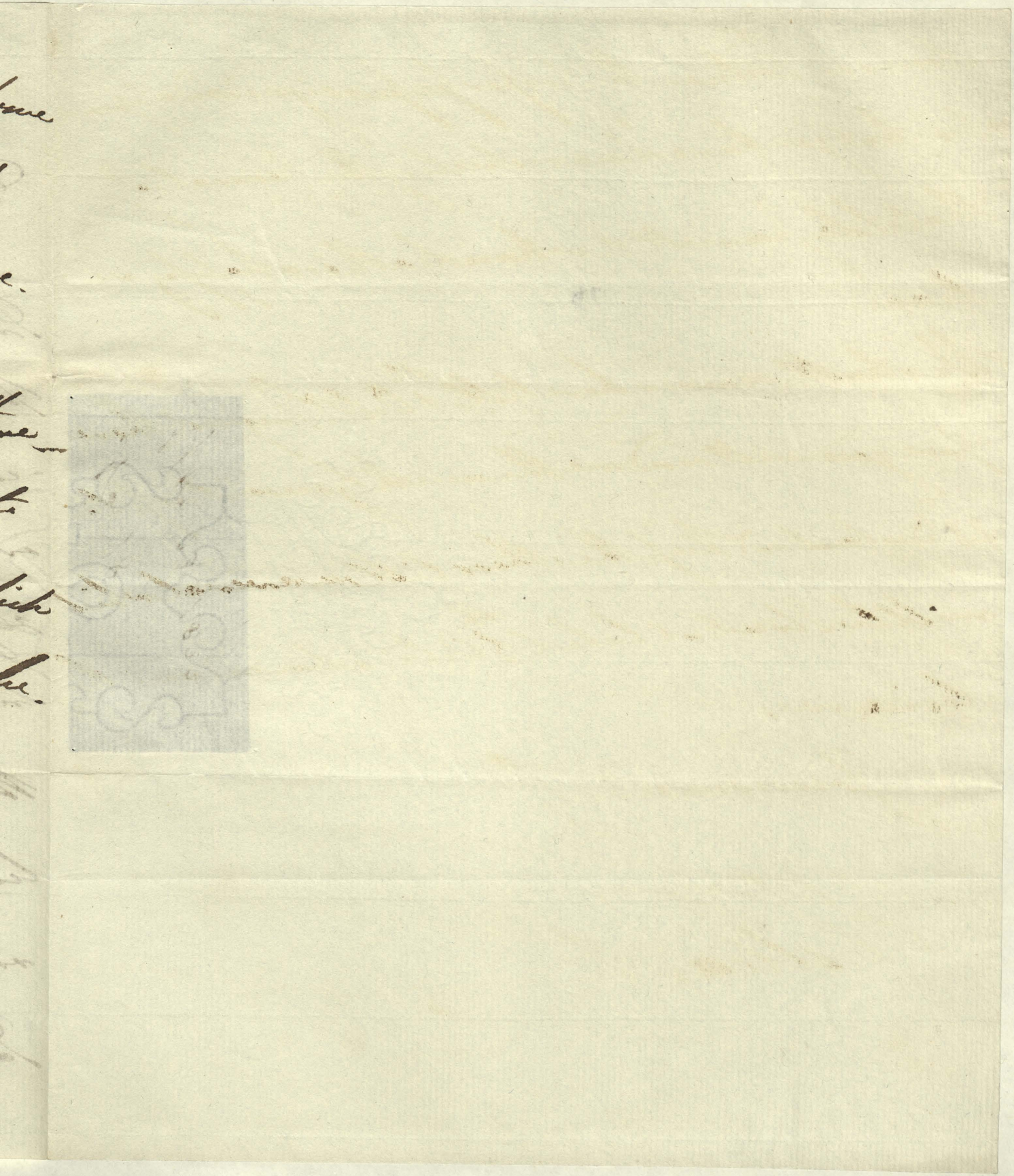
On leaving Frankfurt to come here  
 I received your £10 and its enclosures. I return the  
 proper papers signed and also your own letter be-  
 - cause the whole circumstance is better explained  
 on the spot to the Dutch help to me here I shall not  
 say a word till our return to Bury: either Ber-  
 - neth or the English maid must know something about  
 the matter: of course no blame can attach to you:  
 but I recommend in future to be regularly visiting every  
 now and then once much when I am absent.  
 I received here yesterday your £10 and its enclosures

-enclosed: I return the proper papers signed and approved  
of me that you have done respecting the funeral of  
The lady Jewett to me hand that is a happy re-  
-lease.

We shall remain here till 1<sup>th</sup> Oct: I request therefore  
-if you will send me the new Galleys up to  
28<sup>th</sup> instant and keep the others till our arrival which  
will be about at latest 5 Oct: adieu and ever be.
