returned the proper papers signed.

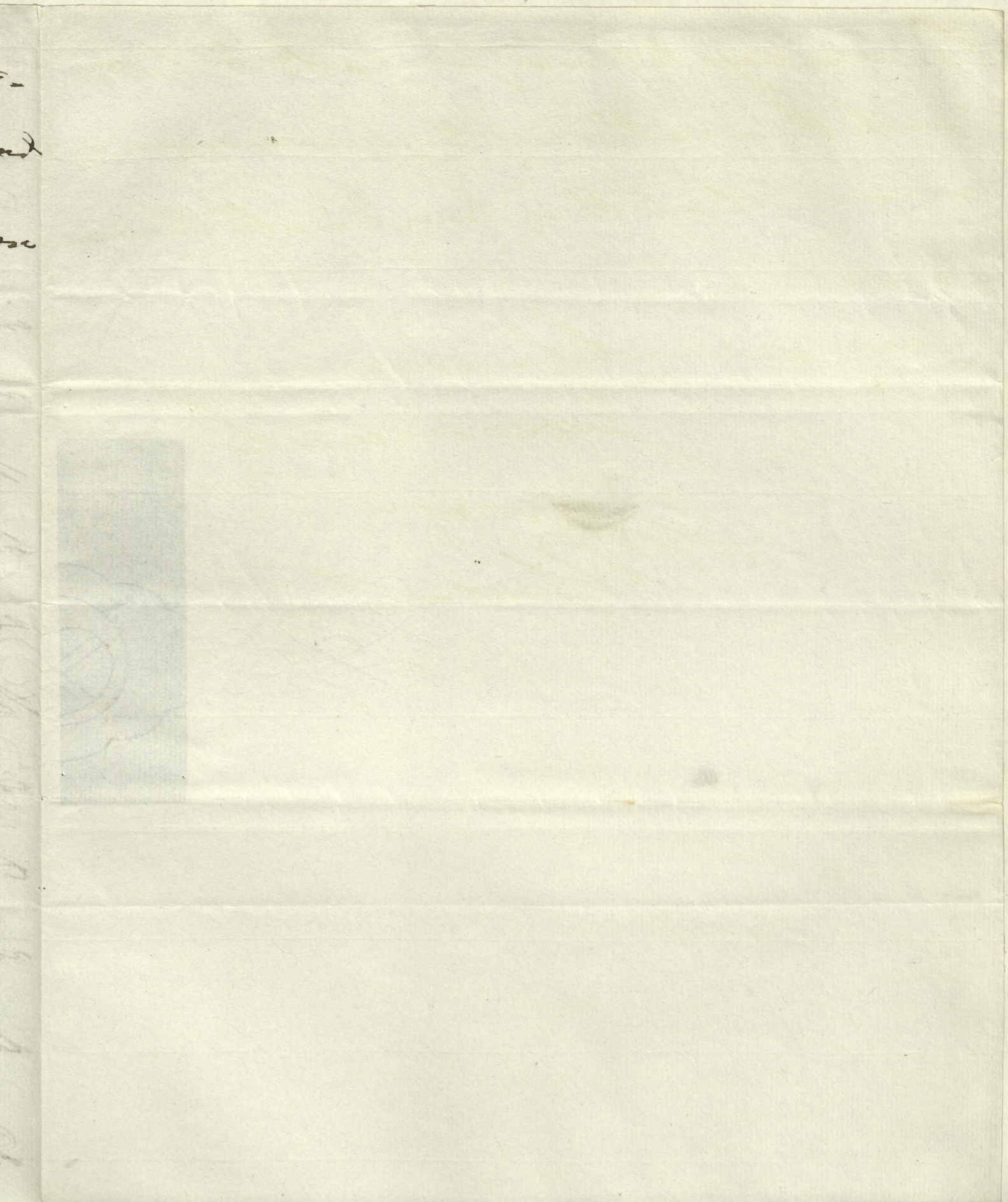
Windsor and Buckingham Palace must
