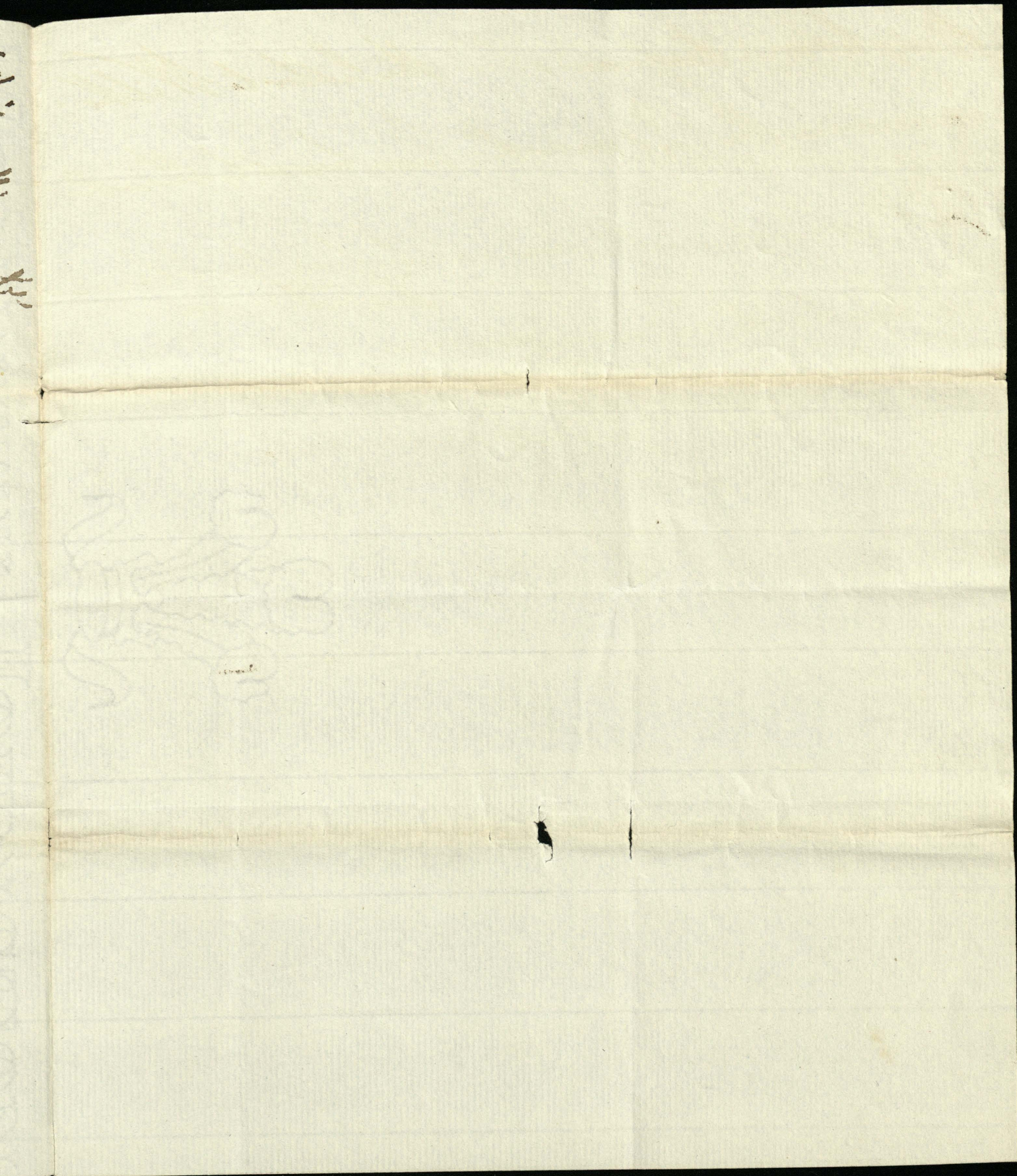
Dear Boston,
