Bushy House
 Decr: 7: 1820.

Sir, I have this instant received from
 of today announcing the melancholy & un-
 expected event of the death of my
 friend Mr. William Huskisson. I am most sincerely
 regret his loss and feel most deeply for
 Maria Huskisson as does the death of a wife desires
 me to express to you her own and my feelings
 in this truly melancholy circumstance which
 we request you will make known to her
 feelings in the kindest and properest manner.
 As you were so fully acquainted with the per-
 sonal regard & attachment for us toward friend.

I am to thank you for this mark of consideration
in having this soon informed me of an event
which must have given you and me such real
affliction. I do most deeply feel for your Lady
