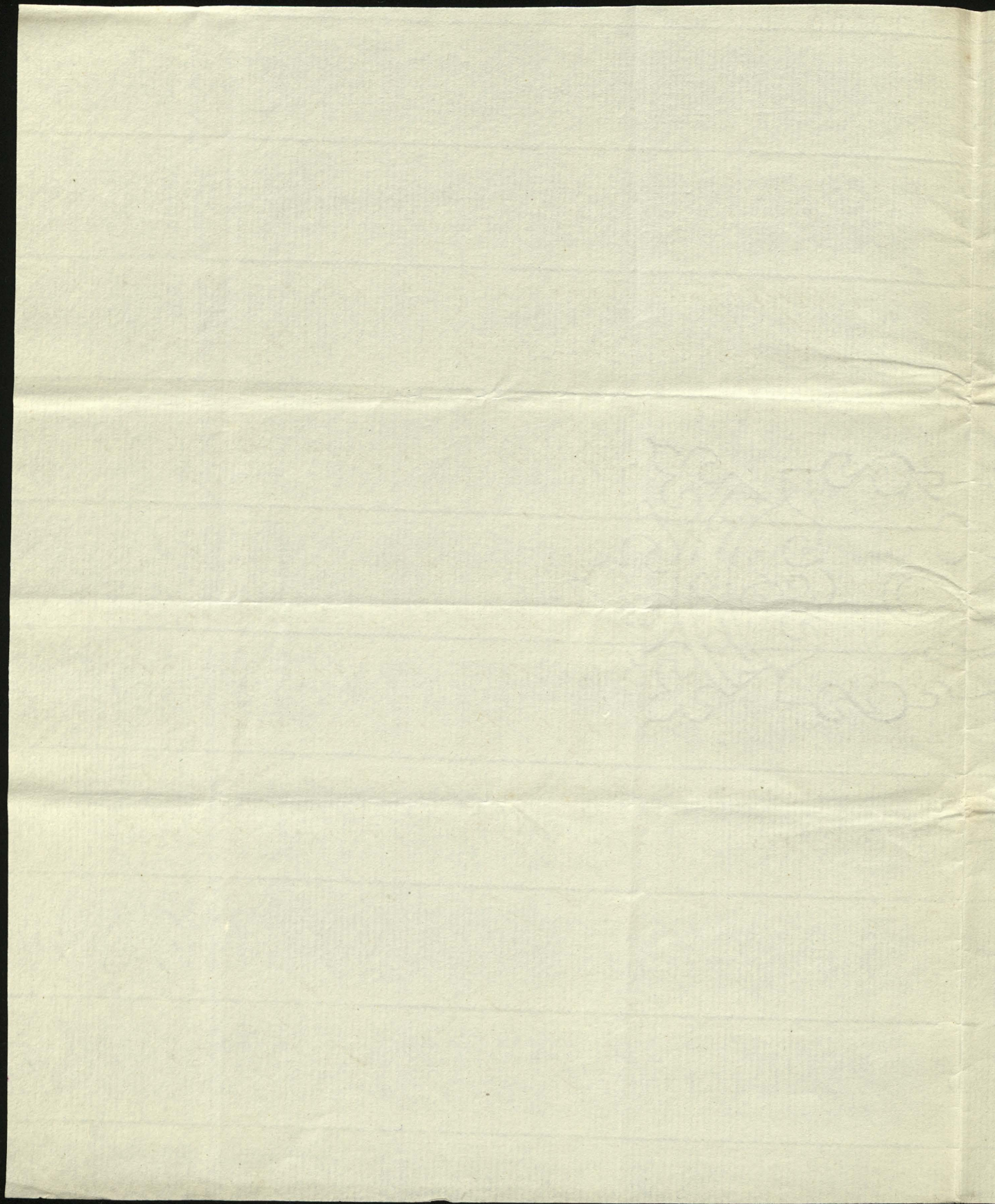


Messrs Greenwood & Co present their
