To Our Most dearly beloved Brother His Royal Highness Adolphus Frederick Duke of Cambridge K. G. &c. &c. Field Marshal of Our Forces Greeting We reposing especial Trust and Confidence in Your Loyalty, Courage, and good Conduct do by these Presents Constitute and Appoint you to be Colonel of Our Coldstream Regiment of Foot Guards from the 5th September 1805.

You are therefore to take Rank in the said Regiment accordingly and duly to Exercise as well the Officers as Soldiers thereof in Arms and to use your best Endeavours to keep them in good Order and Discipline. And We do hereby Command Them to obey You as their Colonel and You are to observe and follow such Orders and Directions from Time to Time as you shall receive from Us or any your superior Officer according to the Rules and Discipline of War in pursuance of the Trust hereby reposed in You Given at Our Court at Saint James the Twelfth day of December 1830 in the First Year of Our Reign.
