I have the honor to send to you enclosed A Petition, with copies of particular documents, which I respectfully intreat you, to lay before his Gracious Majesty The King - I have been advised by Gentlemen of high legal eminence, to adopt this mode of application, as the most proper - the subject of my claim being one, exclusively relating to the private Affairs, of the Royal Family; and that it is the more dutiful remedy, than to apply to any of the legal Officers of the Crown -

The proofs adduced of the sign manual of his late Majesty George the Third, and the handwriting of Lord Warwick, and Mr Dunning, are considered by legal men, to be beyond the boundary of contradiction, and in whatever manner, the unhappy lady to whom the bequest of £15000. was made - Unfortunately incurred the displeasure, of his late Majesty George the Fourth, and his late Royal Highness, the Duke of York - Such settlements are terminated - The unhappy lady is in her Grave, and as I acted for her, from the purest motives to relieve her distress.
