Most Dutiful & most devoted & Loyal Slave & Servant

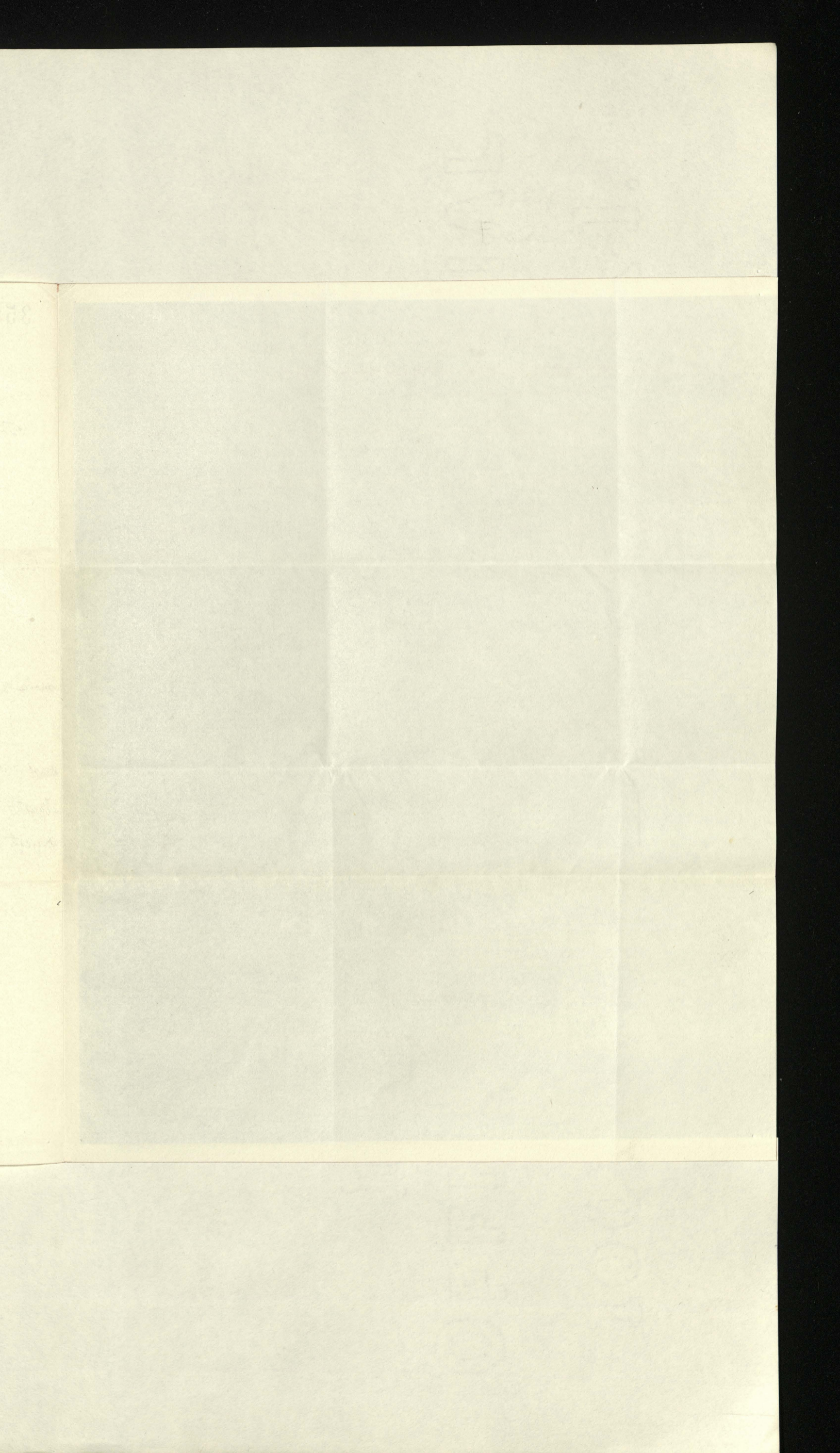
