I have had the honor of laying your memorial before Her Majesty, and I have at the same time communicated to the Queen that I remember having seen Miss Edwardina Kent, amongst the Princess of Wales's attendants during the Princess's stay at Brunswick, — who married there one of the aides de Camp of the late Duke of Brunswick, and who resided for some time with her husband there. —
