Dear Mother,

I am exceedingly ill  
struck so severely to my stomach that it was out

Jordan's return here to dinner. I received a letter  
from Charles Stewart and another from George

gal which gives me great pleasure: for the same  
reason George recd the letter I received a letter from  
Mr Walter Farguhar which makes me quite  
easy relative to George's health and I only hope  
my own will intervene in other respects, as I fear  
he did the last time from Portugal.

Let Thursday me shall meet. I understand at the  
Duke of York's and of course I shall be with you in  
the morning: I am afraid if the cold continues to  
prevail that day I shall not be able to go to town.
