Dear Sir,

The officers who came to me from
the Duke of Clarence with the news of the
victory at Vitoria forgot to mention the
apprehension of journals of the Duke and others
having each met with a check which had
caused Mr. Baker to travel to London to advance and
now an additional expense for our this sum
- being leaving Newcastle: must left last night
at Newcastle in a fine coach and
by the way the Duke of Clarence to the Duke of

Arnhem and proceed with the Baron
this day to visit the Duke has seen General
Kopel, who commands the Prussian and is a
Frenchman. The Duke and myself go to-
morrow to a great ball. My plan is not to
visit the Duke. I believe this is my great object
to be away for some days, and in my pre-
sent quarters. I shall of course, visit as usual
and endeavor to see him.
