Public Order to
Vice Admiral Crown.

By His Royal Highness
Duke of Clarence & St. Andrews,
K. G. K. T. and Knight of
the Order of St. Spirit,
Admiral of the Fleet,
Commander in Chief

His Royal Highness cannot give up
the Command of Vice Admiral Crown and
the Russian Ships without expressing
his entire and perfect satisfaction, through
the Vice Admiral, of the Discipline,
order, Seamanship and Regularity on board
the Russian Ships: - Next to the British
Army, His Royal Highness looks with
peculiar regard to the Russian Service,
and shall ever feel interested in the indi-
vidual welfare of every Russian Officer
and Seaman he has on this occasion com-
manded.

Given on board the Jason, in
the Downs, the 25th April
1814.
