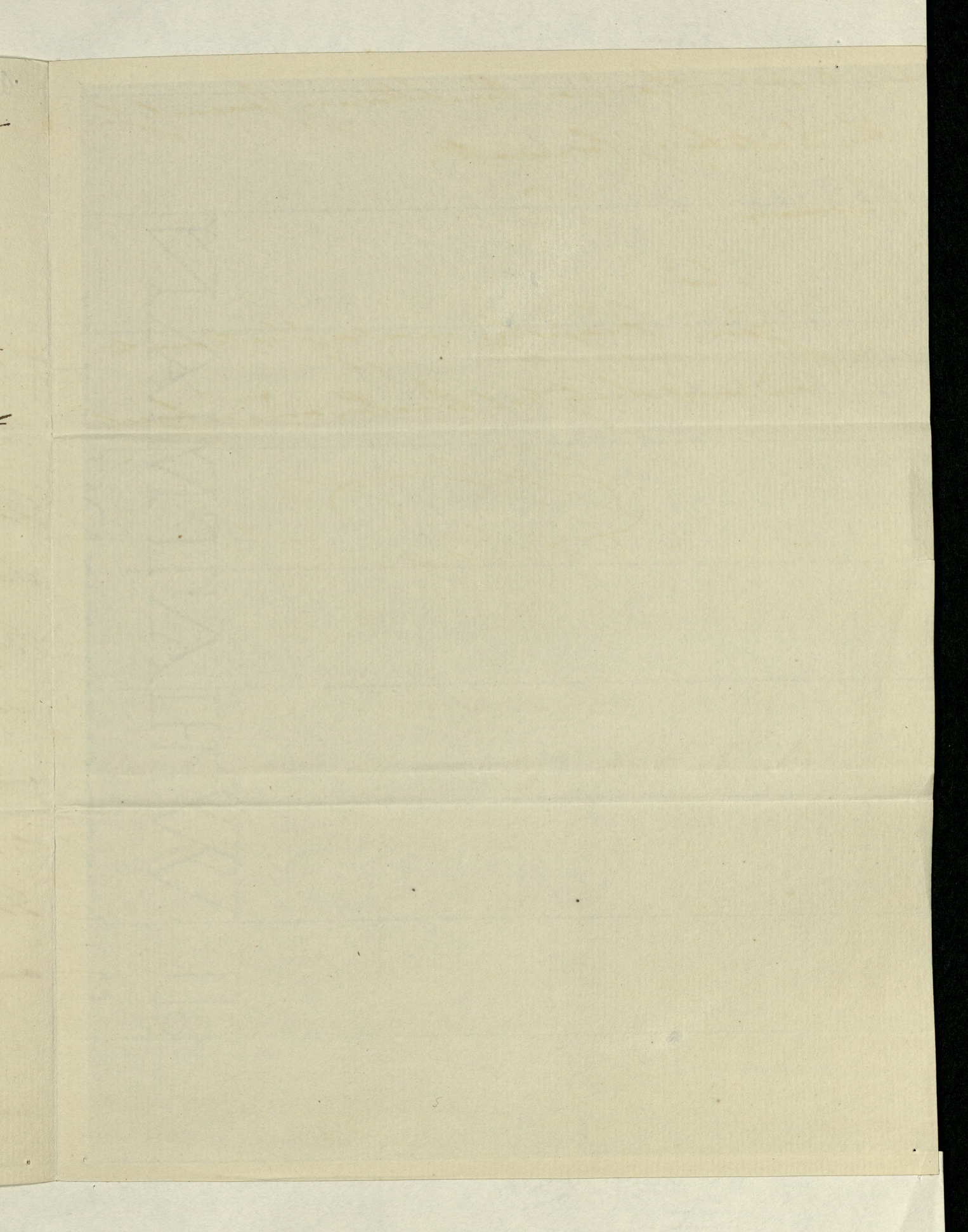
Sir,
