the Service of the King and Queen, that
Whoever goes to pay their Court to Their
Royal Highnesses the Prince and
Princess of Wales, will not be admitted
into Their Majesties Presence.

St. James's 27th Februy 1737

His Majesty having been
informed that due Regard has not been
paid to His Order of the 11th of September
1737, has thought fit to declare that No
Person whatsoever who shall go to
pay their Court to Their Royal
Highnesses the Prince or Princess of
Wales shall be admitted into His
Majesties Presence at any of His
Royal Palaces.
