the kind letters both received yesterday
by the Post - As Anneline wrote herself
yesterday & I had nothing new to say
I would not trouble you in this to day
with a letter - yesterday was a very
unpleasant day with Anneline
much language & pain at times
on the side - She went into the garden
but last night Bedam found her
with some degree of fever which
I am sorry to say continued all
night therefore she has had
but very little sleep & much
disturbed with the pain on the
side as the inward & outward

have been very acute at times & added
 to the dull heavy pain she never
 is without night & day as well
 as this. I thought she had complained
 of at times - every morning & evening this last time
