night, but for all that I remain
fixed but better today & the
pulse less full therefore we
hope the fever is subsiding -
No 74 came in yesterday the
Achilles Sir & King and the
Illustrous Cop in Brandy
I understand they sent in for

Providence Amherst took a drive
yesterday for an hour & that
certainly went off better than
at other times. The weather being
so mild is much in our favor
& it appears now as if it would
last ~~some~~ I try hard to return
you many thanks for your
