My Dearest Mary,

Your kind letter of yesterday appears to be upon the whole more satisfactory than that of the preceding day in regard to the State of dear Amelia, as the febrile tendency appears to have decreased, and as she was able to bear the boring letter and for a greater length of time. I have desired Sophia to write to you respecting the arrangements to be made for your return from Weymouth, & how much regard dear Amelia's accommodation here. She may either reside in her own apartments in the Castle, or in the house that was Doctor Sturden's which Doctor Pope has seen, & as he has not started any objection to either I wish her to consult exclusively her own Inclination, my object being that her comfort should be considered in whatever is settled on the subject.
