 father with a cold fever and weak
 which still obliges me to keep my
 room & has lowered me very much
 but I am much better to day &
 hope it is going off - The success of
 my father's business has been
 instead it has been a complete
 sink & ruin - but thank God is
 going on just as an usual
matter in all respects - He has
 seen the Chancellor and Mr Perceval
 three or 4 times since I wrote last
 every time they have seen him
 they have found him letter
 The King is perfectly recovered

with all that has been going on in
 Public Affairs & feel the Repealing just
 as we could write. His mind much
 relaxed & uncomforted by a
 surprise he has received from the Prince
 and the assurance that all will
 go on just the same & a confidence
 the Prince will do all that is best
 desirable & affair towards the King
 is the best comfort our blood King
 can have — The Prince in the long
 run will feel the Repealing he
 is bringing on himself — He came
 down to see us yesterday all
 Sunday & affair just as you
 remember him at Amquata
bridge where he let his own good
