by the Queen to beg you will

months and when ever they  
ask him to be shown he  
always says No it disposes  
him really, but his general  
health is good —

Sir by his son my son will  
of late with him in the  
struggle but they have  
kept off from us yet —  
Augusta is quite well  
again I fear it is however  
near to the time of the  
Hannibalg's going to France  
I ought to wish him to go  
as it is his duty to do  
but he will be a fool and  
afflict me — His lady health  
however is not in bad health  
but her spirits are萎靡不振  
there was of course  
an end to his attorney  
to us it will of course  
be the same truly living  
joy to succeed him
