I have just been copying my
 eyes out at the most
 beautiful letter I ever read
 that Mr Taylor has received
 from George & his wife

 was half killed and I
 love no more to say
 that I think Mr George Adams
 must be quite something

of George & of bringing me to your

God her health has not
suffered — George says he
wrote to me a few months
ago I have received
no letter from him
for at least a year & a
half — all your own people
at Windsor & I hope very
soon — God bless you

an letter —
