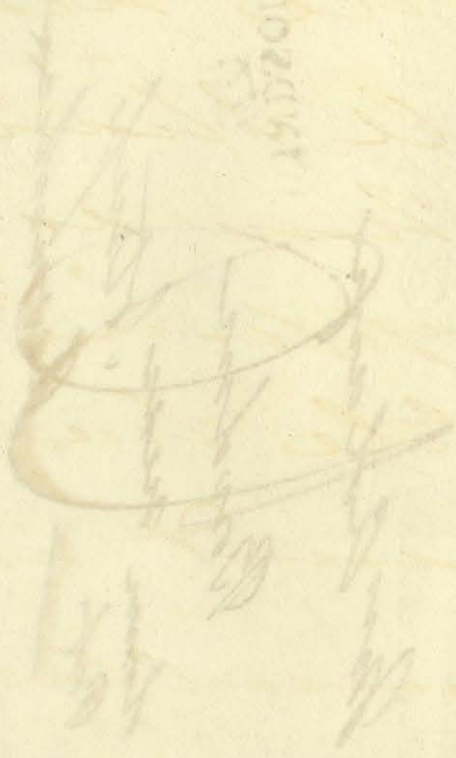
The Opinion of the Phy^{ns}
