 $y^t$  belong to  $y^e$  H. of Austria, Lusatia being by  $y^e$  Emper. Ferd. II.  
yielded to  $y^e$  Elec. of Saxony; & in 1740. Frederick of Prussia  
took possession of Silesia, & by  $y^e$  Peace of Aix la Chapelle in  
1748. has kept it
