Having no manufactures but y. of Copper & other hard wares, they have no other trade but y. & y. great quantity of cattle they annually part with.

They have 10 gold mines, & many of other metals besides copper & hard wares. They only manufacture cloth, which they don't export. Their trade chiefly consists of in cattle, wine, mead, Rock salt, Copper, & Hard wares.
