on the 16th of June last; — and that the Cause of
the two Quarters' Accounts, to the 10th of October 1808, being
transmitted rather later than usual has been owing to
a deficiency of Money in the $\Delta\frac{1}{2}$ p Cent Fund, occasioned
by the want of Sale for the Sugars, which prevented
him from sooner receiving the Amount of His Majesty's
Warrants from The Husband of the $\Delta\frac{1}{2}$ p Cent Duty.

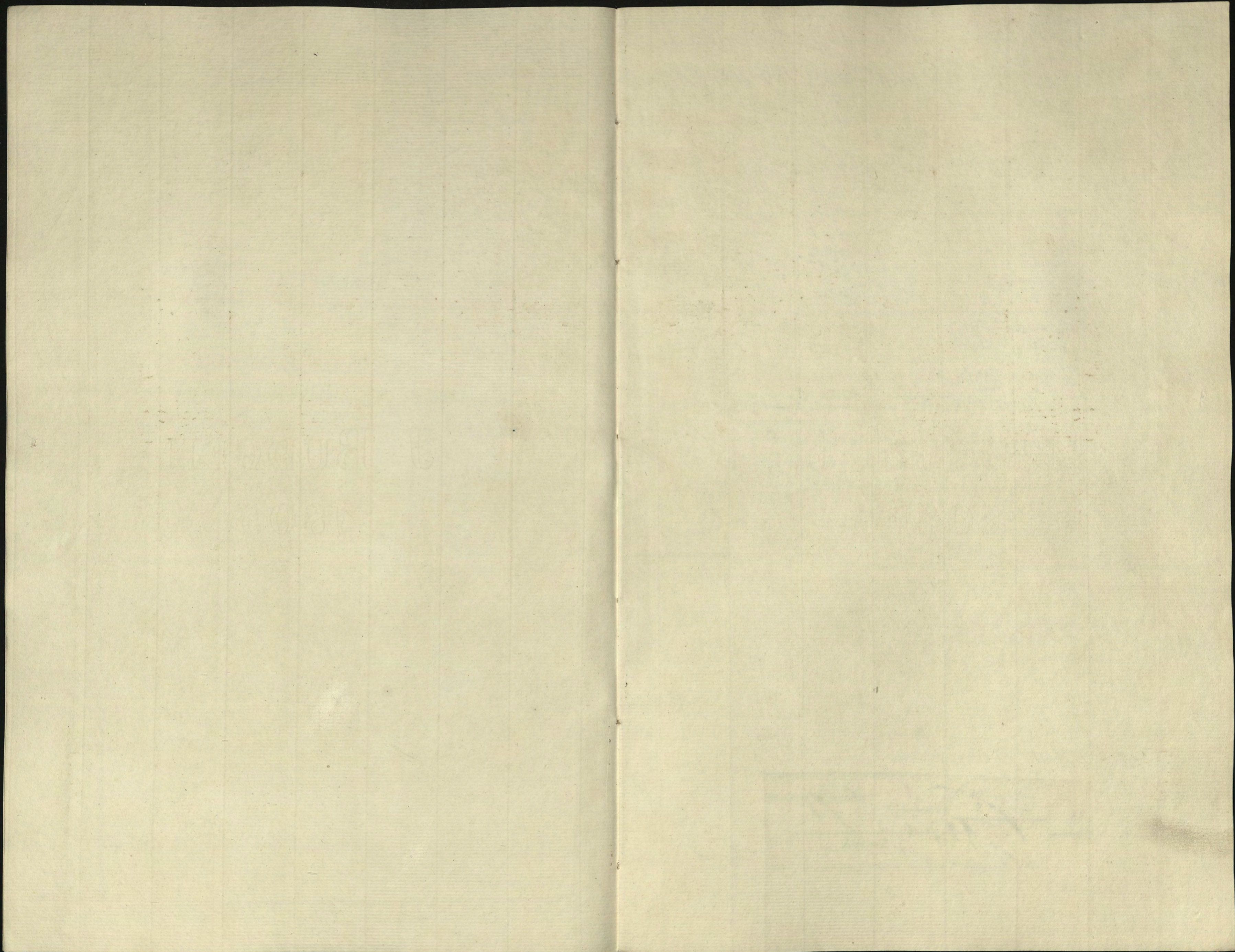


