Lord Bristol, I write with the Lords consent to
desire you will not come on Tuesday Evening till the
Debate is over in the House of Lords, I have authorized
Lord Rochford to say to any others that are in the

Revolution the Corporation Act was established,
the Speakers have not been molested therefore why
must now an alteration be made, this I think
contains the sum of the Argument.
