Lord Rochford has the honor to acquaint your
Majesty that on receiving your Majesty's note last night
I got Mr. Fraser who was in the way & immediately wrote
the inclosed letter to Mr. John Goodricke, which Lord
Rochford flatters himself your Majesty will approve
& of his sending it by a messenger who went away this
morning at two o'clock, it was impossible to put the
whole letters in cypher in time, and there is now a

possibility of Booths arriving in time to prevent the
miscellany, as he has orders to see the utmost Expedition
your Majesty will observe. Sr John Goodrich is strongly
recommended to conceal the Intelligence, & in sending
him the copies, the names on the Top of each letter
were left out. I shall send the two letters by a
messenger to Lord Suffolk this afternoon & acquaint
him with what I have done.
