I forgot to tell your Lordship yesterday that I had left for you with Sir Stancer Patten, a plan by the Transplantation of plants for raising in one or other part of the British Dominions every article of commerce that depends upon vegetable production. I gave the idea to a botanical clergyman in Scotland who executed it exceedingly well. I gave the paper to Lord Bute, when he was in power, if he did not show it to her Majesty your Lordship may, for I am sure it will amuse her.
