Sir Isaac Heard Garter humbly submits to
his Majesty's Inspection and further Pleasure,
the inclosed Labels, intended for Distinctions
in the Armorial Bearings of their Royal
Highnesses, Princes Edward, Ernest, Augustus
& Adolphus;
On account of the Absence
of his Grace the Duke of Norfolk, Earl Marshal,
whose Duty it is to lay before his Majesty the
usual Warrant for the Exemplification & for
marshalling the Arms, Garter has not had
it in his Power to prove, as he earnestly
wished, an earlier Obedience to his Majesty's
Commands on this Subject.
