Though Lord Southampton's reappointment to the  
Office of Groom of the Stole to the Prince of Wales was  
the natural consequence of the Establishment of the  
Prince's Family, the King cannot but look on Lord  
Southampton's having notified it to Him as well as  
his transmitting a List of the Gentlemen that will  
be presented and the Additional Appointments  
as a fresh Mark of that Affectionate Attachment  
he has ever experienced from Lord Southampton  
Lucas House
