As it appears more and more from the arrangements  
secretly made by His Royal Highness Prince Edward  
that it is his intention to set out for England  
and not being able to prevent this step as mentioned  
in my report of yesterday. I have ventured to send  
Capt. Plako to report the circumstances to  
Your Majesty. In case His Royal Highness should  
yet change his plan - and render Capt. Plako's  
journey useless. I trust Your Majesty will not blame  
me on the account it being the only step I can  
take in my situation.
