the Honour of waiting upon Your Majesty: but  
they presume humbly to submit to your  
Majesty's gracious Consideration whether,  
after what has now passed, Your Majesty  
might not think it right to see His  
Royal Highness at an earlier Period,  
than seems to have been in Your Majesty's  
Contemplation for that Purpose.
