May it Please Your Majesty,

In obedience to Your Majesty's Commands I have examined the Accuses leading to Your Majesty's apartments in the factis and have likewise conferred with Miss Toward on the subject, and by permission to submit to Your Majesty my humble opinion that the Old Kitchen on the West side of the Hall might be conveniently fitted up in two rooms for the Housekeeper's Servant and the door which adjoins it opened and placed under his Charge, and that all persons desirous of seeing the factis (so long as Your Majesty may permit the same to be done) should pass up the Staircase on the same side of the Hall — That the Hall would then be reserved entirely for Your Majesty's use & for those only who had immediate business with Your Majesty, and should be placed under the Charge of Your Majesty's



Yeoman Porter, who will attend with  
his Staff of Office, and may be lodged  
in the Rooms now occupied by the  
Housekeeper's Servant.

And that our Under-Porter should  
attend in the Lobby on the East side  
of the Inner Court —
