Windsor letter May 14<sup>th</sup> 1759

My Dearest Sister,

I acknowledge with many thanks the receipt of your letter of yesterday, informing me of the Death of the Duke of Brown, which I shall consider as the official notice of that event and order the mourning accordingly. I am also obliged to you for the communication of the Duke of Brunswicks letter and I have much pleasure in acquainting you, that from the Intelligence which I received yesterday from Germany, the general state of Affairs appears more satisfactory than there had been Reason to hope from the previous accounts.
