Humbly sheweth to your Lordship

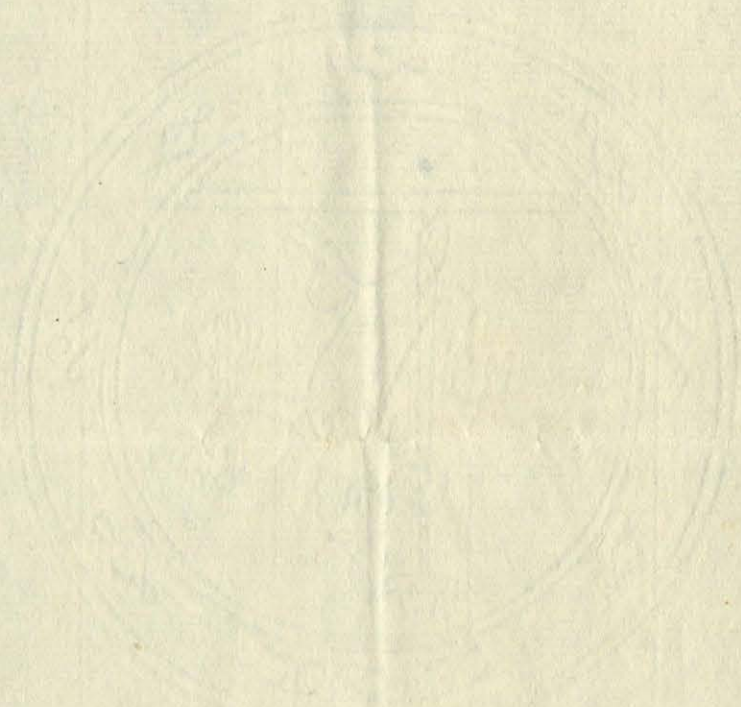
That the following Gentlemen viz: 1^o Thomas Pye - 1^o Richard Spoyr - 1^o Joseph Knight - 1^o Edward Vernon - & 1^o Richard Bickerton having receiv'd the Honour of Knighthood on board his Majesty's Ship the *Carthar* in the Month of June 1773: & conceiving that by the Circumstances of the Royal Standard flying at the main-Top-Mast-Head that they become Knights-Banarrets have inclin'd paying the accustomed Fees for Knighthood till his Majesty's Pleasure touching the Premises be further known

Your Memorialists therefore humbly request that your Lordship would take the Trouble of laying the same before his Majesty praying that his Majesty out of his wonted Goodness would be pleas'd to make known his royal Pleasure that your Memorialists may no longer be depriv'd of their usual and lawful Fees granted to them in the simplest Manner & by the fittest Title under the Sign
