marked A to shew the
manner in which He King
did sign the papers submitted

with each Bundle of
promotions proposed for His
Majesty's approbation, His
Royal Highness will find
rough Memorandums of
the ^{weekly} promotions submitted, with

Marginal remarks in Old
ink, which give the names
of those by whom the appoint-
-ments are recommended,
& other Explanations that
may be satisfactory to His
Royal Highness:
