Lord Liverpool has in obedience to your
Royal Highness's Commands, transmitted
in this Box for your Royal Highness
perusal, and consideration, all Lord
Wellington's Public Dispatches of any
importance, from the 21st of Nov^r last, together
with such Private Letters from his Lordship
as appear to be necessary, for throwing
light upon the present situation of the
Allied Armies in Portugal, and upon
the future Prospects of the Campaign.
If your Royal Highness shall be
pleas'd to signify your Pleasure
that the Dispatches of a Date antecedent
to

7 Feb 1811

to the 21th of Nov^r, should be sent to You
Your Commands in that Respect will
be immediately obey'd

Lord Anson hopes to be able to submit
to your Royal Highness in a few Days,
a Precis of all the Dispatches from
the Officers Commanding in Portugal
and at Cadix, from the Month of
Oct^r 1809, to the present Time
