 his Sons have been killed in the late Warehule Rebellion

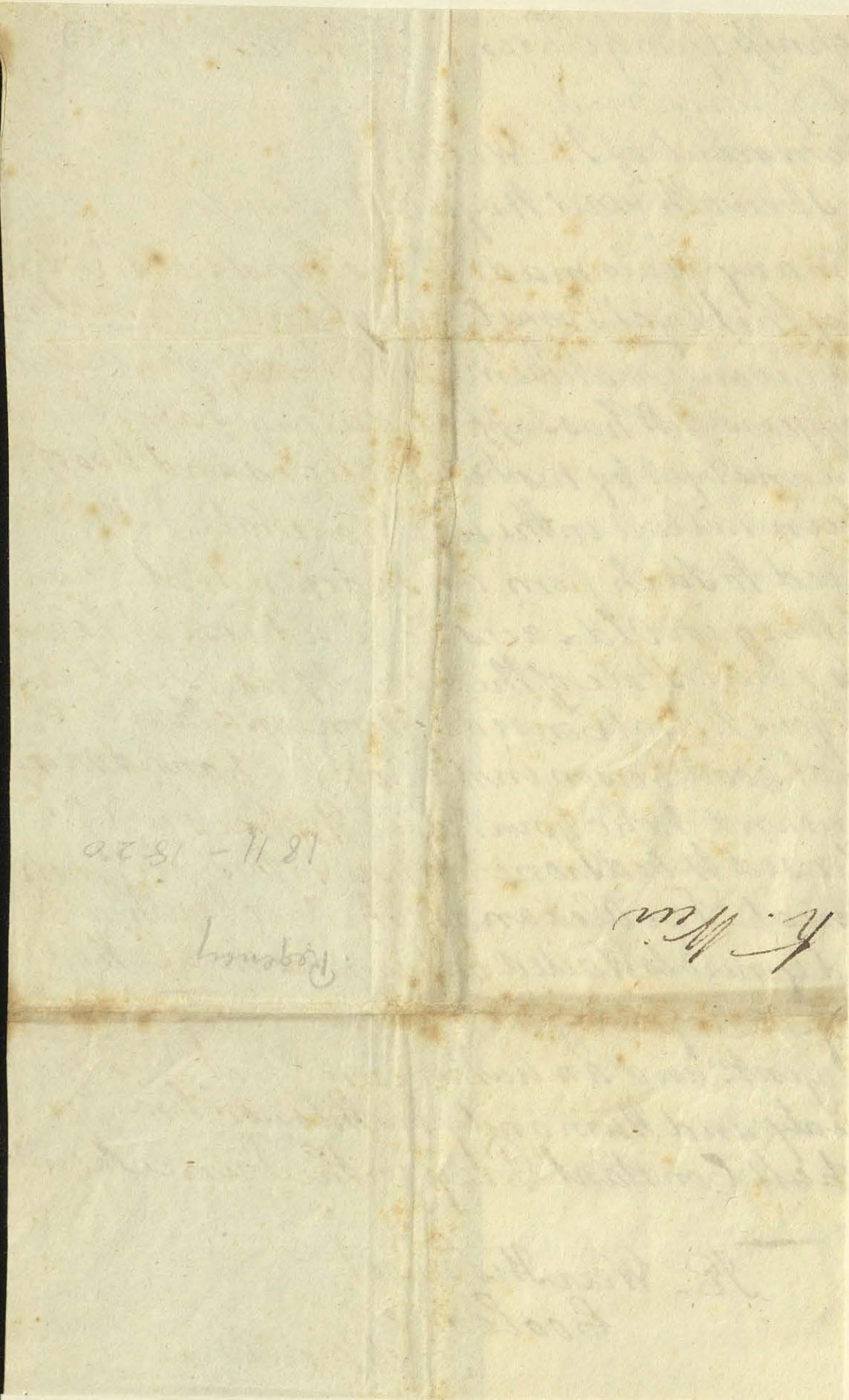
