Highness the Prince's Commands, if he can
leave the House of Lords, where he has
received the Colonel's Note, by the Time
mentioned in it. There is at this Moment
an Appearance of debate, which may run
to Length: at all Events, he will call at
Carleton House when the Lords separate: and
if it is inconvenient to the Prince Regent then
to see him, he will wait upon His Royal Highness
at such other Time, as may suit his Pleasure.
