I have had the honor to lay your Lordship's Letter, with the Representations of Lord Lubbock, before the Prince Regent, and am Commanded by His Royal Highness to assure you that He never promised any support whatever to Lord Gosford in his object of attaining the Vacant Seat in the Representative Peerage of Ireland, nor was His Royal Highness ever even applied to by Lord Gosford for that purpose; But on the contrary, that Lord Lubbock has a very long time since
