report of the Indulge Bill, & order'd  
it to be read the third time on Monday  
The House sat till eleven o'clock, There was  
two divisions which were carried, by  
the friends of the Bill. The first was upon  
a motion made by Mr. Mackintosh for  
granting an optional Jury in all civil  
Cases. The numbers were. { Ayes 40.
