Lord North, By the letters You have received from
Ireland, I find Mr. Flood has declined accepting the
Employment of Aulniger, and that the Lord Lieutenant
intends it for Mr. Blaquiere, I think this very natural
and not improper, but am of opinion ~~he~~ ought not to
have the additional pension granted Mr. Hutchinson,
otherwise the Office will never be on its old
foot, besides 1200. £ is a much larger provision
that was ever given to a Secretary; the Aulniger's
place is worth 1200. and a Red Ribband seem
amply rewarding the talents of Mr. Blaquiere.
