Ld North has the honour of transmitting
to his Majesty a letter he has received
from Dr Davis. His Directions to the
Doctor are. That Arm'd Chairs should
be provided for their Majesties, That
Stools should be placed for the Prince,
& that the rest of the Spectators
should sit upon Benches. But
that the Boys, who were to speak, should
deliver their speeches standing, & sitting
in such a situation, & in such a chair
as the parts they have to perform.

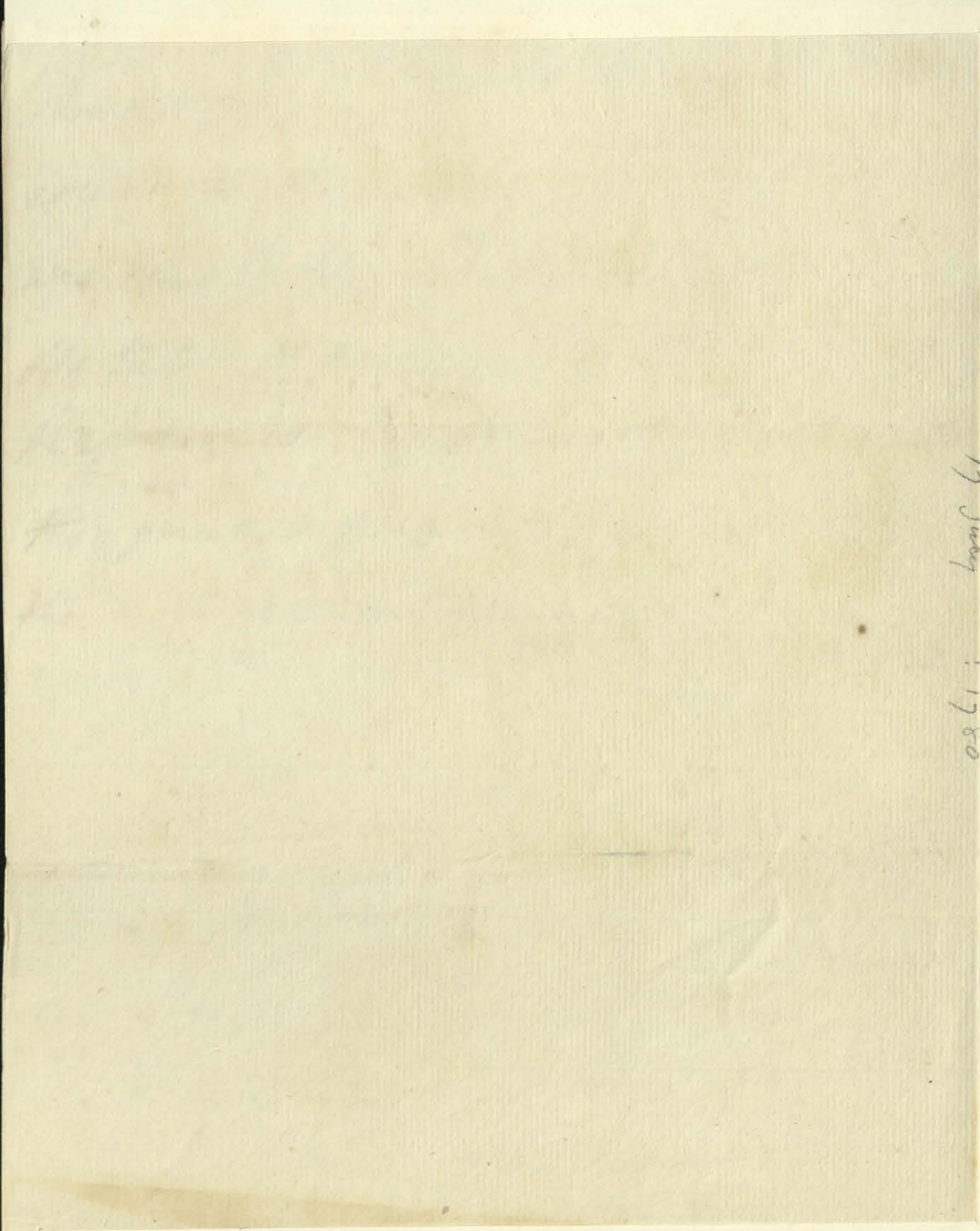
