Lord Wellesley presents his humble Duty to Your Royal Highness, & has the honor to state, that he remained in London from Monday the 2^d of September untill yesterday evening the 15th. He did not request an audience of Your Royal Highness on your return to Town, having carried all Your Royal Highness's commands into execution, & not being desirous of giving unnecessary trouble. He was compelled to leave his house in London on account of the necessity of painting it, which circumstance will oblige

him to reside here for some days, but
he will be at the Office from time to
time, & can always attend Your Royal
Highness's commands in three hours
from the time, that he may have the
honor to receive them.
