Dorking Sept 16th 1811

Lord Wellesley has the honor to acquaint Your Royal Highness, that M. Teu, General Nugent, & Colonel Dornberg arrived safely on board Sir James Saumarez's Flag Ship in Kingo Sound on the 30th & 31st of August, & that every facility has been given to them by the Admiral for the prosecution of their respective Missions.

All the further orders respecting Prussia have been issued in obedience to Your Royal Highness's commands; a Person is appointed to proceed forthwith to Sweden, and

and has received instructions from
Lord Wellesley. The arms & ammuni-
tion for Colberg are embarked, & the
requisite instructions have been sent
to the Admiralty for Sir James
Saumarez with respect to the prospect
of war between Prussia, Russia, &
France.
