Grace on a former occasion, he knows

it must be his Grace's intention to
recommend the Rev. J^r Hall the
Provost of Trinity College to your Royal
Highness, as the Individual; who after
much enquiry and consideration, appears
in point of Character Attainments and
situation in the Country to have the
strongest claims to succeed to a seat
on the Bishop's bench.
